Thank you to the CCE Community for making the Active4Me Scanning Program such a success. We have set up an ACTIVE4ME MONKEY MONEY MART for the month of December. Active4me participants will have until Friday, December 13th to turn in their order forms.

Here is how it works:

1. Every time an Active4Me participant scans in, he/she earns incentive points, or "monkey money", for riding/bus riding/walking/ carpooling to campus. This virtual money (NOT real money) is saved in an account in the Active4me database that is tied to your child's bar code number.
2. Last week and this week, the Active4Me participants got to see a number of items that they could purchase using the virtual monkey money that they earned. Items range in price from 25 cents to \$1.00. Scanners cannot accept real money for these items.
3. Active4Me participants can get an order form from the scanning stations or from the front office or they can print the attached document. They should complete this order form and either give it to one of the scanners or turn it into the envelope in the office. ( Please see attached order form)
