Notice anything different about the CCE gardens this school year?

- You may have noticed purple kale (Carinata kale, a variety of Brassica carinata) growing in many of the gardens. It is very special kale, developed from Ethiopian mustard that you won't find anywhere but Full Belly Farm, Good Humus Farm, and the UC Davis Student Farm - and Ethiopia! Be sure to read about this kale with your child on the signs posted in the garden.
- Many, if not most of the organic vegetables in the garden come from Good Humus Produce, a small family farm and agro ecosystem established in 1976. The farm hosts our second graders each spring for a farm tour deepening their understanding of farm to table concepts and environmental consciousness.
- Stop by the garden near the library with your child and take a look at our working compost bins and worm factory. Add your food scraps from home to the "working" bin - be sure to read signs for instructions.
- Think you don't know enough to volunteer in the garden? Think again! We have lots of resources and garden experts at the disposal for volunteers. Good Humus helps making plant selecting, garden planning and planting very easy - plants are delivered to the school! Just contact one of the coordinators below.
