The Short-Term Emergency Aid Committee (STEAC) of Davis has been helping families and individuals with basic necessities, food and clothing, for over forty-five years. The annual Food Drive at the schools for STEAC will take place this year between Monday, October 14th and Friday morning, October 18th. **Boxes will be placed in front of the school office.** Volunteers from STEAC will pick up the donations on Friday afternoon, October 18th.

Since targeted food drives are the most beneficial in stocking our food closet, students at each school are asked to bring the food item which has been assigned to their school:

- 1) FAIRFIELD - jam or jelly
- 2) PATWIN - canned or bottled juice
- 3) WILLETT - meal-in-a-can, such as pork, chicken breast, ravioli and chili
- 4) CHAVEZ - tuna**
- 5) NORTH DAVIS - canned fruit
- 6) KOREMATSU - cooking oil
- 7) MONTGOMERY - breakfast cereal
- 8) PIONEER - rice in one-pound bags or one-pound boxes
- 9) EMERSON - spaghetti and other pasta products
- 10) HOLMES - meal-in-a-can, such as pork, chicken breast, ravioli and chili
- 11) HARPER - cooking oil
- 12) BIRCH LANE – peanut butter

SIPAT=Spanish Immersion Parents and Teachers (PTA)

DID YOU KNOW?

Sometime in the 2009-10 school year, it was announced that, due to the growing budget crisis, PTAs are now allowed to pay for certain non-credentialed positions. SIPAT rallied and a couple of months later, our first big auction was born so that we could contribute for our Reading Aides! Four years and three more auctions later, we are still committed. This year your PTA will pay \$15k for our wonderful Reading Aides because we believe strongly that a robust Reading Program is a crucial building block that makes **your child** better prepared and more confident as he or she gets older (*Davis Schools Foundation is gifting us \$15k this year or SIPAT would need to pay \$30k!*).

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Ø - As a PTA Board, we also believe school climate is important so we are paying **\$23k** this year to have a fantastic counselor come for 10 hours a week.

Ø - We pay **\$10k** for a Technology Aide to help make sure the computer your kid uses actually works.

Ø - **\$8,500** goes to teachers for supplies so they don't need to pay out of their own pocket.

Ø - **\$5k** also goes to teachers specifically to teach your child art.

Ø - Another **\$5k** pays for substitute teachers around assessment time so our teachers aren't

pulling their hair out finding time to teach *and* assess your child per the State's standards.

For better or worse, SIPAT needs to fundraise a significant amount every year for the foreseeable future to give *all of our kids* strong reading support early to make them successful readers! Maybe one day California will once again pay for these critical positions and PTAs all over can relax.

Until then, please help us pay:

- **\$48,000** for these amazing educators (Reading Aides, Counselor, Tech Aide)
- **\$1500** for Circulo
- **\$500** for a Garden Program
- **\$1200** for Staff Appreciation
- **\$45** to file our tax returns (it's not all glamorous)
- **\$1000** for BRAVO music materials, **etc.**

Playworks Peers 2013-14

Dear Parents of 4th-6th graders:

This week your child will learn about a unique opportunity – a chance to become a Playworks Peer for the 2013-14 school year. We are looking for students in 4th-6th grade who show positivity in their interactions, have great energy, and want to have fun! Any 5th or 6th grader may apply. 4th graders may only apply if they are elected classroom representatives to Student Council.

The Playworks Peers Program offers a position of leadership within the school structure to students in the upper elementary grades. While fulfilling their duties of helping run Playworks

at lunch recess, the students learn the basics of running a healthy sports program. They learn primary job skills like showing up, taking care of business, and cleaning up after themselves. In setting up games and activities and helping other children play them, they learn conflict resolution skills, organizing, problem solving, and anger management. These are skills our students can take with them after they leave CCE and will stay with them to middle school and beyond.

The program requires that once a week your student leaves the classroom a few minutes before their lunch period begins (teachers will give them a 10 minute early release on their shift day). They will come to the playground, help set-up, teach, and monitor the Game of the Week for the 1st-3rd grade recess, and then have 25 minutes to eat their lunch and attend a part of recess before returning to their classroom.

The schedule looks like this:

- * 12:10 early release to playground (upper grade lunch starts at 12:20)
- * 12:10-12:35 Playworks Peers Shift
- * 12:35-1:00 Lunch and Play

Your child will miss class time to attend to some program duties. Children in this program understand that class work comes first and that they are responsible for collecting and making up any work missed. Children who are unable to keep up academically will be asked to take a break from the youth Leader Program until they are better able to balance both responsibilities.

In addition to helping with ONE LUNCH RECESS A WEEK, your child will be asked to attend periodic trainings and meetings. The first training will take place on Wednesday, September 24th, from 10:30-1:30. After this overall training, we will meet as a group once a month on the FIRST WEDNESDAY of every month during lunch recess to go over the upcoming games and deal with any challenges the students may be encountering during their time on the blacktop.

If your child is interested in this program, please complete the parent permission slip and have your child complete the Playworks Peer Application Form. Both can be picked up in the office, from Sra.Caufield in Room 32 or by download off the SIPAT website (www.ccesipat.com <<http://www.ccesipat.com/>>). All forms are due by the end of the day Wednesday, September 18th (turn in to the envelope in the office or to Sra.Caufield in Rm 32).

"Race to Nowhere" Viewing and Discussion, October 16th at 7:30pm at Brunelle~ Presented by Davis High

The film, "Race to Nowhere", is a documentary that calls us to challenge current thinking about how we prepare our children for success. Shown nationwide and internationally in more than

6,000 schools, universities, cinemas, hospitals, corporations, and community centers, "Race to Nowhere" has become the centerpiece of a nationwide, grassroots movement for the transformation of education.

Featuring the heartbreaking stories of students across the country that have been pushed to the brink by over-scheduling, over-testing and the relentless pressure to achieve, "Race to Nowhere" points to a silent epidemic in our schools. Through the testimony of educators, parents and education experts, it reveals an education system in which cheating has become commonplace; students have become disengaged; stress-related illness, depression, and burnout are rampant; and young people arrive at college and the workplace unprepared and uninspired. A school counselor panel will discuss the film after the viewing. We encourage those interested to attend!

CCE Walk and Bike to School Program Update for 2013-14

Welcome back to the new school year! We have a very busy and fun-filled year planned for the CCE Walk and Bike to School Programs.

PROGRAM NAME CHANGE--We want, this year, to educate the CCE community about the fact that our programs can INCLUDE kids and families who are willing to carpool, ride in an electric car, park-and-walk or take the bus, pretty much any mode of transportation might reduce the flow of car traffic in and around the school and might reduce our carbon footprint. So, the program name will now reflect this: CCE WBBC (Walk, Bike, Bus and Carpool) Program.

There are several volunteer opportunities for you to take part in all year long. We welcome any level of support you can provide.

ACTIVE4ME/SCANNING PROGRAM-Most immediately, we desperately need additional parent volunteers who can scan bar codes in the morning.
