NOTICE: The City of Davis is installing a new play structure at Redwood Park

You may have noticed the green signs surrounding the city structure (South side) . According to Dave, Parks Manager with the City of Davis, that structure has “aged out” and will be replaced by a brand new structure (The Warm Remembrance Project). The timeline for this project is as follows:

Beginning in a day or two, a temporary fence will surround the construction area.

Monday, November 10 – dismantling of structure begins.

Installation of new structure will take about two weeks.

The entire process is estimated to take about three weeks with a Grand Opening celebration to be scheduled after completion.
