Of particular note is the steady decrease in comments related to lunch/recess concerns, from 30% in 2012 to 6% for 2015. Such changes are directly related to the work of the administration and climate committee. In response to the high percentage of reports from families on the 2011-2012 survey, committee members and the principal discussed ways to alleviate problems, resulting in a volunteer lunch/recess supervision program and rotation of lunch location by grade level during the first month of school.
