### **COME INTO THE GARDEN!**

During the week please come and explore the gardens with your kids and see the various winter plants growing in our beds.

Some winter vegetables plants you will find are:

Lettuces, peas, fava beans, cauliflower (both purple and white), cabbages, radishes, and of course *Broccoli!*

***Below is a quick and yummy recipe to prepare this popular winter vegetable growing abundantly in local gardens and farms.***

#### **Ingredients:**

- 1 head broccoli
- 1/4 cup water
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes (optional)
- 1/4 Kosher salt and 1/4 freshly ground black pepper

#### **Directions:**

Trim the woody skin off the broccoli stem and slice the broccoli into nice long "trees". In a large saucepan, mix the water, olive oil, garlic, red pepper flakes, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil over high heat. Add the broccoli and cover to steam. After 3 minutes, turn off the heat, and allow the broccoli to sit for another couple of minutes. Toss to coat and serve.
