This week, her entire class is getting bagel and muffin treats to celebrate her "Frozen Fingers" award!

Happy New Year CCE Families! Thanks, again, for your support of our Program. In this new year, we have decided to have a slightly reduced program during the winter months. This means that we will ONLY BE SCANNING ON TUESDAYS, WEDNESDAYS, AND THURSDAYS, effective next Tuesday, January 15th. These are the days we can have both scanning stations fully staffed by volunteers. We have had significant accomplishments over the last two months, including the following:

- Since the program started on November 1st, 92 participants have registered.
- During the month of December, an average of 26 participants biked, walked or carpoled to campus EVERYDAY that school was open.
- Recognition by our community, including a feature article by staff writer Anne Ternus-Bellamy in the Davis Enterprise (*Pedal Power: Street Smarts, Davis Bicycles! Getting Kids on Their Bikes*, Tuesday 12/04/2012)
- Recognition by the League of American Cyclists when a delegation visited Davis schools in early December. The system also automatically informs parents that their child has arrived safely at school, addressing a real or perceived parental safety concern...."
