The fence around the new Warm Remembrance Family Play Area in Redwood Park will come down on Monday, March 2 by 10:00 a.m. The independent playground safety inspection was completed this week after the cushioned Fibar ground surface was installed and a concrete ADA ramp was poured.

The structure can now be used without restrictions during the month-long "soft opening" period. The official dedication of the refurbished play area in Redwood Park will be held on Saturday, April 4 at 1:30 p.m. Additional benches, shade trees and an interpretive sign are planned to be installed in

time for the dedication.

The project is a collaboration between the City of Davis and family, friends and community members who contributed funds to remember former Davis recreation leaders John Riggins and Sabrina Gonsalves.

1. Cartons Needed for Gardening Contest

Los Delfines from salón 16 are sponsoring Cesar Chavez Elementary in a gardening contest called Carton to Garden. The goal is to collect and re-use at least 100 milk and juice cartons in a gardening project, with a chance to win \$1000 for the school garden program. The theme of the CCE project will be "Todo el mundo es un jardín" (All the world is a garden). The plan is to assemble the cartons in a globe shape, planting green plants for the continents and blue flowers for the oceans.

Every student can help! Students can donate their empty milk and juice cartons from lunch and bring cartons from home. Cartons just need to be rinsed out with water before being placed in the collection bin, located near the lunch area. If each family brings just one carton in, that will be over 500 cartons!

Once we have collected all of the cartons, we will set a day for kids to come plant. Students from all classes will be able to participate in the planting, and growing, of our garden globe.

Additionally, there will be a drawing contest for each grade level. Students can submit one drawing around our theme "Todo el mundo es un jardín" (All the world is a garden), or a poster encouraging saving and recycling milk cartons for the Carton 2 Garden contest. To enter, students submit their original artwork to the envelope located at the CCE Garden Shed. The student's name, grade and classroom number should be on the back of the artwork. One winner will be selected from each grade level to receive a gardening prize. Only one entry per student. All entries must be submitted by Friday, March 13th.

2. Redwood Park Playground Update

The City of Davis has informed us that warranty and installation issues have all been resolved with the new equipment in the Redwood Park playground. The concrete curb that goes around the perimeter of the playground needed some repair before concrete could be poured for bench pads and the ADA ramp. After ground cover is installed, the city will schedule an independent safety inspection, with the goal of opening the playground before the end of the month.

In alignment with our mission the DJUSD Board of Trustees, on February 5, 2015, instructed the Superintendent to appoint a committee formed for the purposes of recommending an implementation plan that would adjust the start times for all DJUSD Junior and Senior High schools at or about 8:30 a.m. beginning at the next school year, 2015-16; and request the Superintendent to direct the committee to conclude the development of this implementation plan within 60 days so that the plan could be reported back to the Board within 60 days or at the next regularly scheduled board meeting immediately thereafter.
